

Privacy statement on the protection of personal data

General information

The NPO Benin Sante is committed to user privacy. The policy on protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by Benin Sante is based on REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) and the Austrian DSGVO.

Why do we collect, store and process your data?

Your data are collected to enable the personalization of your access to the system.

We will also use the data to prepare anonymous statistics about the usage of the site.

Collected personal data are treated according to the policy described in the above-mentioned Regulation.

Data will be used only for the above purposes by Benin Sante.

What personal data do we collect?

for personalisation of access to the system (registration) and provision of information: e-mail address, password, chosen fields of interest;

To whom are your data disclosed?

Your collected data will be treated confidentially and used only by Benin Sante.

No personal data is transmitted to parties which are outside the recipients and the legal framework mentioned.

Your rights

You have the right to request a copy of your personal details at any time to check the accuracy of the information held and/or to correct or update this information. You may also ask your personal information to be deleted completely if no enquiry from you is in progress.
